- 8. Within 10 minutes, position and press panel firmly into place.
- 9. For proper installation, it is recommended that each panel be vented. Vent the panel by pulling the panel away from the wall for 3 to 5 minutes, then firmly press the panel back into place. If necessary, use masking tape to temporarily secure panel edges until adhesive has set. Failure to vent may result in damage to tub surround.
- 10. Allow to dry for 24 hours before exposing to water or moisture.
