

Dryer to Duct Connector Kit








Installation


1 ASSEMBLING THE DRYER TO DUCT CONNECTOR

□ Insert the bottom notch (A) into the receptacle (B).




2 SNAPPING THE DRYER TO DUCT CONNECTOR TOGETHER

 Carefully snap the two sections together, ensuring that each lip (C) is inserted into its corresponding V groove (D) (2 per side). The part should make a snapping sound once secured.




3 ATTACHING THE TRANSITION DUCT

 Unravel a 6 in. portion of the duct. Insert the threaded end of the dryer to duct connector into the end of the duct, and turn it clockwise until all threads on the connector grasp firmly inside the duct.



4 ATTACHING THE CONNECTOR TO THE DRYER

 Secure the connector by pushing it over the exhaust port of the dryer until it is firmly in place. Extend the duct, and slide the dryer back against the wall.



Notice

Some dryers may have a recessed exhaust port that will require the optional extension piece (included).
