This duct consists of a flexible helix core made of 2 ply polyester laminate and corrosion resistant zinc coated wire, surrounded by a blanket of glass fiber insulation, jacketed by a heavy duty, fire retardant black polyethylene vapor barrier.

Flexible Insulated Ducting can be installed in place of galvanized pipe in most applications. The insulation blanket and vapor barrier jacket helps reduce heat loss and condensation build up.
