

INSTRUCTIONS

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE WEARING THIS HARD HAT NO HARD HAT CAN PROTECT THE WEARER AGAINST ALL FORESEEABLE IMPACTS

This Hard Hat will only perform as designed if it is used and maintained according to the following instructions. This Hard Hat should be inspected daily for signs of wear, cracks, fractures or environmental degradation. **REPLACE** the Hard Hat immediately if it shows any signs of wear or damage. If the Hard Hat sustains a blow (impact) dispose of it immediately even if the damage is not visible. Failure to do so will diminish the protection and could result in serious injury or death.

CLEANING: Clean the Hard Hat with lukewarm water and mild detergent. **DO NOT USE SOLVENTS, GASOLINE OR CHEMICALS.** Do not apply paint to the Hard Hat.

STORAGE: Store the Hard Hat in it's original plastic bag in a cool or shaded environment, not in direct sunlight.

MAINTENANCE: NEVER ALTER OR MODIFY THE HARD HAT SHELL OR SUSPENSION. Do not remove the foam shock absorbing liner from the Hard Hat. Visibly inspect the Hard Hat daily and discontinue use if signs of wear, aging or abuse are visibly evident.

FITTING THE HARD HAT

P.R.P.L. RATCHET HEADBAND MODEL: The harness is adjusted by pulling the ratchet knob out of locked position and turning the knob to either tighten or loosen the fit of the hard hat until it feels comfortable. Push the knob back into locked position once hat is fitted appropriately.

PROPER USE: For proper protection the Hard Hat must fit, or be adjusted to fit the size of the head of the wearer. The Hard Hat is designed to absorb the energy of a blow from falling objects by partial destruction or damage to the shell, suspension or other components. If the Hard Hat is subjected to a severe blow it should be disposed of immediately, even if the damage is not visibly apparent.

ACCESSORIES: Only use original Degil Safety Hard Hat replacement parts, such as headband suspension. Failure to comply will void all appropriate approvals and warranties. Do not apply labels, self adhesive labels, paint or solvents to the Hard Hat.

SERVICE LIFE: Degil Safety Products warrants to the original purchaser that the hard hat and suspension system are free of defects in material and workmanship under normal service and use for a period of two (2) years.

As the manufacturer of your hard hat, we recommend that you replace the following:

Suspension: replace after no more than 12 months of use.

Shell: Replace after no more than 5 years of use.
